12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
14 Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated
15 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
17 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
18 imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
20 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System shall budget all funds in the
21 following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law shall be set by the
8 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System. The
9 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System for the fiscal year ending June 30,
10 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
11 full-time-equivalent employees, except those used for the statewide
12 Trial Indigent Defense System, and expenditures except as may be
13 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
14 the Oklahoma Statutes:
