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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
13 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System shall budget all funds in the
14 following categories and amounts:

20 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
21 each budget category.

22 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law shall be set by the

1 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System. The
2 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System for the fiscal year ending June 30,
3 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
4 full-time-equivalent employees, except those used for the statewide
5 Trial Indigent Defense System, and expenditures, except as may be
6 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
7 the Oklahoma Statutes:
