12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
14 Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise
15 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
17 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
18 the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by
19 law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Board
21 of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by
8 the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not
9 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Board of Medicolegal
11 Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
12 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
13 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
14 capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may
15 be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74
16 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
