12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
14 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
15 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
6 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
7 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
8 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

9 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
10 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
11 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
12 except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding
13 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
14 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
15 the Oklahoma Statutes:
