12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
14 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the
9 Commissioner. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year
10 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
11 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures,
12 except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include
13 cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their
14 employment in probationary status, excluding expenditures for
15 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
16 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
17 Statutes:
