ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 221 - By: JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate and MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House.

(State Board of Career and Technology Education – appropriation - budgeting
- duties and compensation - salary of Director -
effective date)

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Career and
2 Technology Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
3 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
4 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
5 the duties imposed upon the State Board of Career and Technology Education by law.

6 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State Board of Career
7 and Technology Education shall budget all funds in the following categories and
8 amounts:

3 The State Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each
4 budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed
6 by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of
7 Career and Technology Education by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the
8 Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall not
9 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal
10 year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology
11 Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
12 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
13 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to
14 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
