ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 223 - By: JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate and MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House.

(State Election Board - budgeting - duties and compensation - salary of Secretary - effective date)

1 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State Election Board
2 shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget
10 category.

11 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed
12 by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Election Board by law

1 shall be set by the Secretary of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of
2 the State Election Board shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
3 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The State Election
4 Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
5 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
6 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
7 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
