ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 228 - By: JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate and MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House.

(Oklahoma Department of Commerce – appropriation - budgeting - duties and compensation - salary of Executive Director -
effective date)

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
2 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
3 of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
4 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
5 duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law.

6 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Oklahoma Department
7 of Commerce shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget
5 category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed
7 by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of
8 Commerce by law shall be set by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive
9 Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall not exceed _____
10 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

11 The Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall
12 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
13 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
14 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
15 Statutes:
