ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 236 - By: JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate and MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House.

( public finance - Rural Economic Action Plan Fund - effective date )

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 2004, as last amended by  
2 Section 1, Chapter 194, O.S.L. 2007 (62 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 2004), is amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 Section 2004. A. The monies appropriated to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund  
5 ~~shall be~~ are subject to all of the requirements of Sections 2006 through 2013 of this title.

6 B. In a fiscal year for which the amount appropriated to the Rural Economic Action  
7 Plan Fund is less than or equal to the sum of Fifteen Million Five Hundred Thousand  
8 Dollars (\$15,500,000.00), there shall be deposited into each of the accounts provided by  
9 Section 2006 of this title the sum of one-tenth (1/10) of the amount appropriated to the  
10 Rural Economic Action Plan Fund with the exception of one account which shall be  
11 divided equally into two subaccounts. One of the two subaccounts shall be available to  
12 one and only one of the entities described by subsection B of Section 2007 of this title for

1 distribution to cities or towns within the respective jurisdiction of the entity if the  
2 population of such city or town does not exceed seven thousand (7,000) persons according  
3 to the latest Federal Decennial Census or for the benefit of an unincorporated area.  
4 Funds may also be expended for any city or town with a population below seven thousand  
5 (7,000) persons based upon the current population estimate according to the U.S. Census  
6 Bureau. Funds may be expended for such cities and towns until the next following  
7 Federal Decennial Census. Provided, for any fiscal year following the first fiscal year  
8 that the provisions of subsection D of this section have taken effect, funds appropriated  
9 to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund shall be deposited as provided in subsection D of  
10 this section and the provisions of this subsection shall not be in effect.

11 C. In a fiscal year for which the amount appropriated to the Rural Economic Action  
12 Plan Fund is greater than Fifteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars  
13 (\$15,500,000.00), but less than Seventeen Million Fifty Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$17,050,000.00), there shall be deposited into each of nine separate accounts for the  
15 entities described by subsection A of Section 2007 of this title the sum of One Million  
16 Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,550,000.00). There shall be divided equally  
17 between two additional accounts for the use and benefit of the entities described by  
18 subsection B of Section 2007 of this title the balance of any such appropriation in excess  
19 of Thirteen Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$13,950,000.00), but less than  
20 Seventeen Million Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$17,050,000.00).

21 D. In the first fiscal year for which the amount appropriated to the Rural Economic  
22 Action Plan Fund equals or exceeds the sum of Seventeen Million Fifty Thousand Dollars

1 (\$17,050,000.00), and in every subsequent fiscal year, there shall be deposited an equal  
2 amount to each of eleven accounts created for the use and benefit of the entities  
3 described by subsections A and B of Section 2007 of this title.

4 E. Regardless of the number of accounts created based upon the appropriation  
5 amount to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund, all expenditures from all accounts shall  
6 be governed by the limitations imposed pursuant to Sections 2002 through 2013 of this  
7 title, including the limitations applicable to expenditures for the benefit of cities or towns  
8 based upon population limits or expenditures for the benefit of unincorporated areas.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
