**Senate Bill No. 54**

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 54 - By: CORN of the Senate and BRANNON of the House.

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and Cleanup Services Act; stating exceptions for certain railroads and electric utilities; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1           SECTION 1.   NEW LAW   A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 2-7-406 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in  
3 numbering, reads as follows:
- 4           A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and Cleanup Services  
5 Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from rail transportation, vehicles or cargo at  
6 locations including, but not limited to, highway, street or road intersections or other  
7 locations involving railroad tracks.
- 8           B. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and Cleanup Services  
9 Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from vehicles, cargo or electrical equipment  
10 under the control of an electric utility.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
2 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
3 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
