ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 757 - By: BURRAGE AND JOHNSON
(CONSTANCE) of the Senate and STEELE of the House.

[public health and safety - Oklahoma Health Information Security and
Privacy Collaboration - codification -

effective date]

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1-722.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 The Oklahoma Health Information Security and Privacy Collaboration (OKHISPC)
5 shall evaluate potential barriers to the broad adoption of standards-based electronic
6 health information systems, including electronic health records and statewide health
7 information exchange. These barriers may include, but are not limited to:

- 8 1. Broadband access;
- 9 2. Penetration;
- 10 3. Capacity;
- 11 4. Application program interface availability and development; and

1 5. Health information technology (HIT) systems acquisition and ongoing
2 operational costs, including hardware, software, licensing, support staff, and training
3 expenses.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
