A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Fort Cobb-Broxtton Lady Mustangs for winning the 2009 Class A fast-pitch softball state championship; and directing distribution.

1 WHEREAS, the Fort Cobb-Broxtton Lady Mustangs have always been competitive,
2 whether in slow-pitch or fast-pitch softball. The Lady Mustangs were runners-up in the
3 fast-pitch finals in 2007; and

4 WHEREAS, Lady Mustangs Coach Kelly Pierce decided to change his line-up
5 during the 2009 fast-pitch softball championship game against the top-ranked Fletcher
6 Lady Wildcats by sending in Freshman Ashton Lierle to pitch and assigning senior
7 pitcher Adalynn Klugh to the shortstop position; and

1 WHEREAS, the new line-up worked as the Fletcher team, which had faced Adalynn
2 Klugh before, was unfamiliar with Ashton Lierle; and Adalynn’s defensive play and at-
3 bat prowess proved decisive. Adalynn Klugh hit the game-winning run batted in (RBI) in
4 her last two championship games, and Coach Pierce’s team won its first fast-pitch
5 softball state championship on the same ASA field where his team prevailed in its slow-
6 pitch softball state championship game.

8 SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF
9 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
