17 A Concurrent Resolution recognizing the importance of
18 breast cancer awareness; designating April 26, 2010,
19 "Breast Cancer Awareness Day"; and directing
20 distribution.

21 WHEREAS, one in every eight women will be diagnosed with breast
22 cancer in her lifetime. Breast cancer is the leading cause of
23 cancer deaths in women ages 15 to 54. More than 11,000 young women
24 are diagnosed with breast cancer each year. For more than 1,000 of

1 these women, the disease is fatal. More than 250,000 women
2 diagnosed with breast cancer are under the age of 40; and

3 WHEREAS, men as well as women are at risk for breast cancer and
4 need to be educated about their risks. Education is important
5 because early detection is sometimes the only way to save lives; and

6 WHEREAS, many Oklahoma grassroots organizations, support groups
7 and clinics are providing support, education, and treatment for men
8 and women affected by breast cancer; and

9 WHEREAS, this April marks the 26th anniversary of National
10 Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
12 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13 CONCURRING THEREIN:

14 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature recognizes the importance of
15 breast cancer awareness and education for all men and women.

16 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature designates April 26, 2010,
17 "Breast Cancer Awareness Day" in the State of Oklahoma.

18 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Judi Grove of
19 Breast Impressions, Inc., in Tulsa, Oklahoma; and the Central
20 Oklahoma Affiliate and the Tulsa Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the
21 Cure.
