ENGROSSED SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 21 - By: CRAIN AND JOHNSON  
(CONSTANCE) of the Senate and COX AND PITTMAN of the House.

[ Joint Resolution - Oklahoma Health Care Authority - feasibility - technology -  
distribution ]

- 1       WHEREAS, online health registries allow patients to preregister their vital health
- 2 information and prerequest In Case of Emergency (ICE) contact information; and
- 3       WHEREAS, online health registries allow consumers to give emergency responders
- 4 limited access to vital health information in the event of an emergency; and
- 5       WHEREAS, online health registries increase the capacity of emergency medical
- 6 service providers to provide proactive care via electronic health access services; and
- 7       WHEREAS, online health registries improve coordination of care for patients
- 8 transported by emergency medical service providers; and
- 9       WHEREAS, online health registries reduce health care waste associated with
- 10 unnecessary emergency medical transports and hospital utilization.

4           SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Legislature directs the Oklahoma Health Care  
5           Authority to study the feasibility of implementing the use of online health registries for  
6           Medicaid beneficiaries.

8           Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
