6 ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1084 - By: Thomsen, McCullough and Roan of
7 the House and Paddack of the Senate.

8 [Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training -
9 agreement - peace officers - codification - effective date]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.11 of Title 70, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. Beginning November 1, 2009, any peace officer attending a
15 basic law enforcement academy conducted by the Council on Law
16 Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) shall execute an
17 agreement with CLEET whereby the peace officer promises to remain
18 within the law enforcement profession in the State of Oklahoma in a
19 position approved by rules and regulations of CLEET for four (4)
20 years following graduation from the basic law enforcement academy,
21 subject only to such disqualifications as established by CLEET and
22 included within the agreement between CLEET and the peace officer.

23 B. Violation of the provisions of this section or the terms of
24 any contract or agreement entered into pursuant to this section

1 shall give rise to a civil action which may be commenced by CLEET
2 for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma for restitution of any
3 and all sums paid by CLEET on behalf of the peace officer plus costs
4 and reasonable attorney fees. The provisions of this section shall
5 not apply to persons who volunteer or are drafted into active
6 military service subsequent to receiving CLEET training at state
7 expense.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
