COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1554 - By: Duncan
of the House and Newberry of the Senate.

An Act relating to municipal sewage sludge; prohibiting
municipal solid waste landfills from disposing certain
sludge; stating requirements for acceptance; authorizing the
Department of Environmental Quality to renew, suspend or
revoke landfill permits for certain violations; providing
for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-10-402.1 of Title 27a, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A municipal solid waste landfill shall not accept for
disposal any municipal sewage sludge unless:

1. The sludge has been treated to meet Class B requirements for
pathogen reduction, as specified in Section 503.32 of Title 40 of
the Code of Federal Regulations; and

2. The sludge is demonstrated not to contain free liquids
pursuant to the Paint Filter Liquids Test, EPA Method 9095, or any
successor free liquids test hereafter adopted by the United States

1 Environmental Protection Agency and approved by the Department of
2 Environmental Quality.

3 B. The Department may refuse to renew, or may suspend or
4 revoke, a permit issued to a municipal solid waste landfill pursuant
5 to the Oklahoma Solid Waste Management Act for willful violation of
6 the requirements of this section. The authorization for suspension,
7 revocation or nonrenewal pursuant to this subsection is in addition
8 to any other remedies for noncompliance available to the Department
9 pursuant to the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
