ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2274 - By: Thomsen, Pittman, Cannaday,
Smithson and Walker of the House and Anderson of the Senate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-118.1, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1-118.1 The building fund of any technology center
school district shall consist of all monies derived from the
proceeds of a building fund levy of not to exceed five (5) mills in
any year, voted by the people of a school district pursuant to the
provisions of Article X, Section 10, of the Oklahoma Constitution,
monies appropriated by the state for the purpose of capital
expenditures or projects, and monies donated to a school district
for the purpose of capital projects or improvements and may be used
for erecting, remodeling, repairing or maintaining school buildings,
~~and~~ for repairing and maintaining computer systems and equipment,
for purchasing furniture, equipment and software for instructional
and noninstructional purposes, for purchasing energy and

1 telecommunications utilities, for paying fire and casualty insurance
2 premiums for school facilities, for purchasing security systems, and
3 for paying salaries of security personnel, or for one or more, or
4 all, of such purposes. Proceeds of such levies shall not be
5 required to be used during the year for which a levy is made but may
6 accumulate from year to year until adequate for the purposes
7 intended. The building fund hereinabove defined is hereby declared
8 to be a current expense fund, but shall not be considered a part of
9 the general operating fund. No monies derived from the proceeds of
10 the school levies made pursuant to the provisions of Article X,
11 Section 9B of the Oklahoma Constitution may be placed in the
12 building fund provided by this section.

13 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
