6 ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2297 - By: Duncan, Osborn, Kirby, Kern,  
7 Ritze, Faught, Luttrell and Pittman of the House and Brown of the  
8 Senate.

9 [ intoxicating liquors - underage drinking - increasing  
10 penalties - effective date ]

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 312, O.S.L.  
13 2006, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 365, O.S.L. 2007 (37 O.S.  
14 Supp. 2009, Section 8.2), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 8.2 A. No person shall knowingly and willfully permit  
16 any individual under twenty-one (21) years of age who is an invitee  
17 to the person's residence, any building, structure, or room owned,  
18 occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person or on any land  
19 owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person, to  
20 possess or consume any alcoholic beverage as defined by Section 506  
21 of ~~Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, any controlled  
22 dangerous substance as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous  
23 Substances Act, or any combination thereof, in such place.

24 B. Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause  
25 great bodily injury ~~or the death of a person~~, shall, in addition to

1 any other penalty provided by law, be guilty of a felony, punishable  
2 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for  
3 not more than ~~five (5)~~ ten (10) years, or a fine of not less than  
4 Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five  
5 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.  
6 Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause the  
7 death of a person, shall, in addition to any other penalty provided  
8 by law, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the  
9 custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than five (5)  
10 years nor more than life imprisonment and a fine of not less than  
11 Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than Twenty Thousand  
12 Dollars (\$20,000.00).

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
