6 ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2552 - By: McCullough, Ritze, Duncan,  
7 Wright (John), Jett and Thompson of the House and Anderson of the  
8 Senate.

9 An Act relating to firearms; amending 19 O.S. 2001, Section  
10 215.29, which relates to the carrying of firearms by  
11 district attorneys; authorizing assistant district attorneys  
12 to carry firearms under certain circumstances; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.29, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 215.29 A. A district attorney may carry a firearm on  
18 his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal  
19 protection if ~~he~~ the person has successfully completed an approved  
20 course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms  
21 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms  
22 training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education  
23 and Training.

24 B. At the discretion of the district attorney, the district  
25 attorney may allow an assistant district attorney to carry a firearm  
26 on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal

1 protection if the person has successfully completed an approved  
2 course of firearm training conducted by a state-certified firearms  
3 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms  
4 training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education  
5 and Training, and has been employed as an assistant district  
6 attorney for at least two (2) years.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
