6 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2696 - By: Roan,  
7 Luttrell and Pittman of the House and Crutchfield, Eason McIntyre  
8 and Johnson (Constance) of the Senate.

9 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating  
10 the Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn Memorial Highway;  
11 designating the PFC Lonnie D. Loyd, Jr. Memorial Highway;  
12 designating the George Freas Memorial Bridge; designating  
13 the Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge; designating the 95th  
14 Division Memorial Highway; designating the E. A. Woods  
15 Memorial Highway; designating the Representative Opio Toure  
16 Memorial Highway; designating the USMC Cpl. Jeremy D.  
17 Allbaugh Memorial Highway; designating the James W.  
18 Summerlin Memorial Highway; designating the Walter Merrick  
19 Memorial Highway; designating the Raymond Mallouf Memorial  
20 Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers;  
21 providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless  
25 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

26 That portion of State Highway 7 from the Atoka city limits  
27 extending west to the Johnston County line shall be designated as  
28 the "Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn Memorial Highway". The  
29 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
30 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 That portion of State Highway 48 from the junction of State  
5 Highway 48 and State Highway 7 extending north to the Johnston  
6 County line shall be designated as the "PFC Lonnie D. Loyd, Jr.  
7 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
8 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that  
9 name.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge on State Highway 31 approximately four (4) miles  
14 southwest of Ashland in Coal County shall be designated the "George  
15 Freas Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall  
16 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing  
17 that name.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.63 of Title 69, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge crossing Bull Creek on East State Highway 60  
22 approximately one (1) mile east of the junction of East State  
23 Highway 60 and State Highway 2 in Craig County shall be designated

1 the "Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
3 on the bridge bearing that name.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.64 of Title 69, unless  
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 That portion of Interstate 44 located in Comanche County from  
8 the junction of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 extending north to  
9 mile marker 46 shall be designated as the "95th Division Memorial  
10 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
11 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

12 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.65 of Title 69, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The portion of State Highway 46 from the junction of State  
16 Highway 46 and State Highway 15 extending south to the junction of  
17 State Highway 46 and the Sharon-Shattuck Road shall be designated as  
18 the "E.A. Woods Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation  
19 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway  
20 bearing that name.

21 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.66 of Title 69, unless  
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1           The portion of Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City between Northeast  
2 23rd Street and Interstate 40 shall be designated as the  
3 "Representative Opio Toure Memorial Highway". The Department of  
4 Transportation shall place suitable permanent markers on the highway  
5 bearing that name.

6           SECTION 8.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.67 of Title 69, unless  
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9           The portion of State Highway 11 in Blackwell between Interstate  
10 35 and 13th Street shall be designated as the "USMC Cpl. Jeremy D.  
11 Allbaugh Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall  
12 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing  
13 that name.

14           SECTION 9.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.68 of Title 69, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17           The portion of State Highway 88 between Inola and Claremore  
18 shall be designated the "James W. Summerlin Memorial Highway". The  
19 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
20 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

21           SECTION 10.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.69 of Title 69, unless  
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1           The portion of State Highway 66 from the I-40 loop at exit 25 to  
2 4th street in Sayre shall be designated as the "Walter Merrick  
3 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
4 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing  
5 that name.

6           SECTION 11.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.70 of Title 69, unless  
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9           The portion of State Highway 152 from the I-40 loop at exit 23  
10 to 3rd Street in Sayre shall be designated as the "Raymond Mallouf  
11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
12 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing  
13 that name.

14           SECTION 12. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
