House Bill No. 2912

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2912 - By: Morgan, Dorman and Wright (John) of the House and Coates and Gumm of the Senate.

An Act relating to oil and gas; making it unlawful to injure, deface, alter, destroy, or tamper with oil and gas safety equipment; providing an exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 320.2 of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

After the effective date of this act, it shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally or maliciously injure, deface, alter, destroy or tamper with any safety equipment that is not their own and is used in the drilling or production of an oil or gas well, unless consent is given by or the person is authorized by the owner or operator of the safety equipment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
