House Bill No. 3366

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 3366 - By: Jett and Pittman of the House and Jolley of the Senate.

An Act relating to counties and county officers; providing short title; authorizing certain entities to provide support services to county sheriffs; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Marvin Williams and Robbie Chase Whitebird County Sheriff Assistance Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 556 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A corporation organized not for profit pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma General Corporation Act that holds a valid exemption from federal income taxation issued pursuant to Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C., Section 501(a)) and is listed as an exempt organization in Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)) and represents elected sheriffs of this state is hereby authorized to provide any

4 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
