5 SENATE BILL NO. 1033 - By: Sparks of the Senate and Armes of the  
6 House.

7 [ agriculture - wrongful injury - cervidae - codification -  
8 emergency ]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-511 of Title 2, unless there  
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. No person shall wrongfully injure any cervidae upon the  
14 premises of a farmed cervidae facility or wrongfully remove any  
15 cervidae from the premises of a farmed cervidae facility.

16 B. Any violation of the provision of subsection A of this  
17 section shall be deemed a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall  
18 be punishable by a fine not less than Five Thousand Dollars  
19 (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a  
20 period not exceeding two (2) years, or both such fine and  
21 imprisonment. In addition, any person violating the provisions of  
22 subsection A of this section shall be liable for damages of not less  
23 than three (3) times nor more than ten (10) times such a sum as  
24 would compensate for the actual detriment.

1           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
