SENATE BILL NO. 1124 - By: Sykes of the Senate and Terrill of the House.

[attorneys - legislative approval - rules and amendments - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19 of Title 5, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Legislature may by concurrent resolution disapprove any existing rule of the Code of Judicial Conduct.

B. The Legislature shall by concurrent resolution approve or disapprove a proposed new rule or a proposed amendment to the Code of Judicial Conduct prior to such rule taking effect. Any such proposed rule or proposed amendment to a permanent rule shall be approved by both houses of the Legislature or such rule or amendment to a permanent rule shall be deemed disapproved. Any such concurrent resolution shall not require the approval of the Governor, and any such rule deemed disapproved shall be invalid and of no effect regardless of the approval of the Governor of such rule.
