SENATE BILL NO. 1125 - By: Sykes of the Senate and Wesselhoft of the House.

[torts - immunity from liability - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7.1 of Title 76, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person who in good faith and exercising due care in making a report of alleged terrorist activity of another person or persons to a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or agency or other security personnel shall have immunity from any civil or criminal liability that might otherwise be incurred or imposed. This section shall not apply to any person who willfully or recklessly makes a false report to a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or agency or other security personnel.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
