COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1156 - By: Anderson of the Senate and Billy of the House.

[ language - English - codification - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 401 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

English shall be designated as the common language of Oklahoma. Except as otherwise provided by federal or state law, no agency or political subdivision of this state shall be required, and no person shall have a cause of action against an agency or political subdivision of this state for failure to provide any documents, information, literature or other written materials in any language other than English.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
