As Amended

SENATE BILL NO. 1250 - By: Nichols of the Senate and Terrill of the House.

[ crimes and punishments - prohibiting storage of DNA on newborn - codification - emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1175 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A laboratory, medical facility, hospital or birthing place is prohibited from the unauthorized storage, transferring, use or databasing of DNA from any newborn child without express parental consent.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
