SENATE BILL NO. 1324 - By: Russell of the Senate and Sullivan of the House.

[ motor vehicles - levying fee on motorcycles - requiring collection and payment of fee - codification - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132.6 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In addition to other vehicle registration fees specified by law, there is levied and there shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) upon every motorcycle registered pursuant to Section 1132 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for use on roads and highways. The fee shall accrue and shall be collectible upon each motorcycle registered for use on roads and highways under the same circumstances and shall be payable in the same manner and times as apply to the registration of motorcycles for use on roads and highways under the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee shall be paid in full for the then current year at the time any vehicle is first registered in a calendar year.

1           B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section  
2 shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety  
3 for deposit in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving  
4 Fund created pursuant to Section 40-123 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma  
5 Statutes.

6           C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this  
7 section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any  
8 motorcycle.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
