SENATE BILL NO. 1691 - By: Nichols, Laster and Gumm of the Senate  
and Terrill of the House.

[ schools - fees for membership - codification - effective  
date - emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-155 of Title 70, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No public school or school district in this state shall pay fees  
for membership in an organization which coordinates and regulates  
interscholastic activities and contests in which its member schools  
may participate unless the organization complies with:

1. The Administrative Procedures Act;
2. The Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; and
3. The Oklahoma Open Records Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
