SENATE BILL NO. 1768 - By: Schulz of the Senate and Wright (Harold) of the House.

[revenue and taxation - in lieu of sales tax - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2001, Section 1503.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1503.1 The following coin-operated vending devices shall be exempt from the provisions of this article, Section 1501 et seq. of this title:

1. All coin-operated vending devices owned by and located in a public or private school, a church, or a governmental entity or where there is an agreement between the owner of such devices and the public or private school, church, or governmental entity whereby the organization receives all of the revenue from sales;

2. All coin-operated vending devices which dispense only newspapers or periodicals;

3. All coin-operated vending devices which dispense only postage stamps; and

1 4. All coin-operated vending devices installed on federal
2 military bases.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
