SENATE BILL NO. 1782 - By: Myers of the Senate and DeWitt of the House.

[agriculture - authorizing Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to sell equipment - promulgate rules - directing deposit - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-14.4 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may sell any used vehicles, used emergency vehicle equipment, or any other used equipment of the Department determined to be surplus to the needs of the Department to any federal, state, county or municipal agency or public school district.

B. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may sell at public auction any used vehicles, used emergency vehicle equipment, or other used equipment of the Department determined to be surplus to the needs of the Department.

1 C. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
2 shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of subsections A
3 and B of this section.

4 D. Proceeds from any sale pursuant to subsection A or B of this
5 section shall be deposited in the State Department of Agriculture
6 Revolving Fund.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
