Senate Bill No. 1785

SENATE BILL NO. 1785 - By: Bingman of the Senate and McCullough of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Officer Larry W. Cantrell and Mr. Charles L. Cantrell Memorial Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 66 in Sapulpa from the intersection of 96th Street (Hilton Road) to 100th Street shall be designated the "Officer Larry W. Cantrell and Mr. Charles L. Cantrell Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing their names.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
