6 [professions and occupations - exempting persons from
7 licensing - codification - effective date -
8 emergency]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4002 of Title 59, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The owner of property, or an owner's agent, who attempts to
14 determine cost estimates or various material options or secure a
15 detailed list of materials based upon a drawing or plan or any
16 professional source of written information for his or her
17 construction project shall not be held liable for the acts of, or
18 deemed to practice, a profession or trade required to be licensed in
19 this state.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
