Senate Bill No. 1886
As Amended

SENATE BILL NO. 1886 - By: Schulz of the Senate and Hickman of the House.

[intoxicating liquor - sale of bottled wine at different locations - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 537.4 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any winery licensed in this state to produce wine upon its premises may sell its bottled wine product to another winery licensed in this state to produce wine upon its premises, and in so selling bottled wine between wineries, each winery agrees that any bottled wine product in its possession may be sold to the public either upon the premises of the winery or at another licensed location.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
