SENATE BILL NO. 2087 - By: Sykes of the Senate and Wesselhoft of the House.

[ state officers - state officers salaries - providing salaries - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 250.4, is amended to read as follows:

Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of office which commences in, or after, January, ~~1999~~ 2011, the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court~~ of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);

2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty thousand (30,000)~~ of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

1           3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~  
2 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil Appeals~~  
3 of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars  
4 (\$132,825.00);

5           4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive  
6 a salary ~~equal to the salary received by a district judge of One~~  
7 Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars  
8 (\$124,373.00);

9           5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a  
10 salary ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge~~  
11 ~~in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of~~  
12 One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars  
13 (\$114,713.00);

14           6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~  
15 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~  
16 ~~population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One Hundred Fourteen~~  
17 Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

18           7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary ~~equal~~  
19 ~~to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county~~  
20 ~~with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One Hundred~~  
21 Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

22           8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary  
23 ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a~~

1 ~~county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One~~  
2 Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars  
3 (\$114,713.00); and

4 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary ~~equal to~~  
5 ~~the salary received by a special judge~~ of One Hundred Five Thousand  
6 Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
