SENATE BILL NO. 2293 - By: Crain of the Senate and McCullough of the House.

[crimes and punishment - relatives who cannot hold office -
district judges and special judges -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 484, is amended to read as follows:

Section 484. Any person related within the third degree by affinity or consanguinity to any elected member of the legislative, judicial or executive branch of the state government shall not be eligible to hold any clerkship, office, position, employment or duty for which compensation is received in the same agency as such elected member of the state government.

For purposes of this section, district judges and associate district judges, in judicial districts with a population exceeding four hundred thousand (400,000) in the last Federal Decennial Census, shall not be deemed to be employed by the same agency as special judges.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
