4 SENATE BILL NO. 249 - By: Justice of the Senate and Osborn of the  
5 House.

6 An Act relating to cities and towns; permitting certain  
7 national criminal history record check; providing for  
8 certain investigation; providing for certain costs;  
9 providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 29-103.1 of Title 11, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. Prior to appointing a paid member of a municipal fire  
15 department, each department may conduct a national criminal history  
16 records check, as defined by Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the  
17 Oklahoma Statutes.

18 B. Each applicant shall furnish the department with two  
19 completed fingerprint cards and a money order or cashier's check  
20 made payable to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation for the  
21 fee for a national fingerprint criminal history records check. The  
22 Bureau shall retain one set of fingerprints in the Automated  
23 Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) and submit the other set to  
24 the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for a national criminal  
25 history records check.

1           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
