SENATE BILL NO. 678 - By: Laster, Brogdon, Ivester, Myers and Rice
of the Senate and Jett of the House.

[energy - Secretary of Energy - energy policy -
noncodification -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. The Legislature hereby directs the Secretary of Energy to
create an energy policy for our state, including legislative
recommendations necessary to implement such policy, and to
distribute such copies to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of
the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later
than December 1, 2009.

B. The Secretary of Energy may consult with any persons or form
any committees or working groups the Secretary deems necessary and
appropriate, and is further authorized to solicit assistance from
any agency of this state to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
