6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 1-118.1, which relates to the technology  
9 center school district building fund; expanding uses  
of the building fund; clarifying language; and  
declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-118.1, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1-118.1 The building fund of any technology center  
17 school district shall consist of all monies derived from the  
18 proceeds of a building fund levy of not to exceed five (5) mills in  
19 any year, voted by the people of a school district pursuant to the  
20 provisions of Article X, Section 10, of the Oklahoma Constitution,  
21 monies appropriated by the state for the purpose of capital  
22 expenditures or projects, and monies donated to a school district  
23 for the purpose of capital projects or improvements and may be used  
24 for erecting, remodeling, repairing or maintaining school buildings,

1 ~~and~~ for repairing and maintaining computer systems and equipment,  
2 for purchasing furniture, equipment and software for instructional  
3 and noninstructional purposes, for purchasing energy and  
4 telecommunications utilities, for paying fire and casualty insurance  
5 premiums for school facilities, for purchasing security systems, ~~and~~  
6 for paying salaries of security personnel, or for one or more, or  
7 all, of such purposes. Proceeds of such levies shall not be  
8 required to be used during the year for which a levy is made but may  
9 accumulate from year to year until adequate for the purposes  
10 intended. The building fund hereinabove defined is hereby declared  
11 to be a current expense fund, but shall not be considered a part of  
12 the general operating fund. No monies derived from the proceeds of  
13 the school levies made pursuant to the provisions of Article X,  
14 Section 9B of the Oklahoma Constitution may be placed in the  
15 building fund provided by this section.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
