6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 70 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 6-129.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 24,
9 O.S.L. 2004 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 6-129.1),
10 which relates to the Minority Teacher Recruitment
11 Advisory Committee; re-creating the Committee; and
12 modifying termination date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 6-129.1, as
15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 24, O.S.L. 2004 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009,
16 Section 6-129.1), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 6-129.1 A. There is hereby re-created until July 1,
18 ~~2010~~ 2014, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law, a Minority
19 Teacher Recruitment Advisory Committee which shall have oversight
20 over implementation of the Minority Teacher Recruitment Center and
21 shall advise the operation of such Center. The Advisory Committee
22 shall be composed of nineteen (19) members. The presence of ten
23 Advisory Committee members or their designees shall constitute a
24 quorum. Appointments shall be made by July 1 with members serving a

1 term of two (2) years unless no longer eligible. The Advisory
2 Committee members shall be appointed as follows:

3 1. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint:

4 a. two members from the Oklahoma House of
5 Representatives,

6 b. two members from an institution of higher education in
7 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. One
8 appointee shall be from a comprehensive university.
9 One appointee shall be from a two-year college,

10 c. one member who is a public school teacher who is a
11 minority,

12 d. one member who is a superintendent or designee of a
13 public school district, and

14 e. two members representing a community with a high
15 minority population. One appointee shall be African-
16 American. One appointee shall be Hispanic;

17 2. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint:

18 a. two members from the Oklahoma State Senate,

19 b. two members from an institution of higher education in
20 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education with a
21 teacher preparation program. One appointee shall be
22 from a regional university,

23 c. one member who is a public school teacher who is a
24 minority,

1 d. one member who is a principal of a public high school,
2 and

3 e. two members representing a community with a high
4 minority population. One appointee shall be American
5 Indian. One appointee shall be Asian-American;

6 3. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction or a designee
7 shall serve as a member of the Advisory Committee;

8 4. The Chancellor of Higher Education or a designee shall serve
9 as a member of the Advisory Committee; and

10 5. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Commission for
11 Teacher Preparation or a designee shall serve as a member of the
12 Advisory Committee.

13 B. Members of the Advisory Committee shall be reimbursed for
14 attendance at the Advisory Committee meetings by the appointing
15 agency pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act or Section 456
16 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Members of the Advisory
17 Committee shall designate from among the members a chairperson and
18 vice-chairperson. Staff assistance shall be provided by the
19 Minority Teacher Recruitment Center.

20 C. Persons who are members on the effective date of this act
21 shall retain their membership until their terms are completed.

22 D. The Minority Teacher Recruitment Advisory Committee shall:

23 1. Make recommendations on the annual operating budget of the
24 Minority Teacher Recruitment Center and verify that the funds

1 allocated to the Center through the Oklahoma State Regents for
2 Higher Education are utilized exclusively by the Center by function;

3 2. Advise the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education of
4 unmet needs within the state in the implementation of the Center's
5 activities;

6 3. Annually comment publicly on the progress of the Center;

7 4. Assist the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education in
8 developing and reporting information about the Center when
9 necessary;

10 5. Meet as often as necessary to conduct business; and

11 6. Keep official minutes of the Committee meetings which shall
12 be made available to the public upon request.

13 E. As used in this section and Section 6-130 of this title,
14 "minority" means a person who is a lawful resident of the State of
15 Oklahoma and who is:

16 1. African-American, a person having origins in any of the
17 black racial groups of Africa;

18 2. Hispanic, a person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central
19 or South American descent;

20 3. Asian-American, a person having origins in any of the
21 original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian
22 subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands; or

1 4. American Indian and Alaskan Native, a person having origins
2 in any of the original peoples of North America.
