6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 59 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 481, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 10,  
9 O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 481), which  
10 relates to the State Board of Medical Licensure and  
11 Supervision; re-creating the Board; and modifying  
12 termination date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 481, as  
15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 10, O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp. 2008,  
16 Section 481), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 481. A State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision  
18 hereinafter referred to as the "Board", is hereby re-created, to  
19 continue until ~~July 1, 2009~~ \_\_\_\_\_, in accordance with  
20 the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall be  
21 composed of seven (7) allopathic physicians licensed to practice  
22 medicine in this state and represent the public and two (2) lay  
23 members. The physician members of the Board shall be graduates of  
24 legally chartered medical schools recognized by the Oklahoma State  
Regents for Higher Education or the Liaison Council on Medical

1 Education. The physician members shall have actively practiced as  
2 licensed physicians continuously in this state for the three (3)  
3 years immediately preceding their appointment to the Board. All  
4 members of the Board shall be residents of this state and shall be  
5 appointed by the Governor as provided for in Section 482 of this  
6 title. All present members of the Board shall continue to serve for  
7 the remainder of their current terms.
