6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 10-112, as last amended by Section 2,  
9 Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2008 (11 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section  
10 10-112), which relates to the appointment of city  
11 manager; modifying certain residency requirement for  
12 city manager; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 10-112, as  
15 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2008 (11 O.S. Supp.  
16 2008, Section 10-112), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 10-112. The council shall appoint a city manager or a  
18 part-time city manager, pursuant to this act, by a vote of a  
19 majority of all its members subject to the terms of employment  
20 established by the council. It shall choose the city manager or  
21 part-time city manager solely on the basis of executive and  
22 administrative qualifications with special reference to the actual  
23 experience in, or the knowledge of, accepted practice in respect to  
24 the duties of the office. ~~At the time of appointment, the city  
manager need not be a resident of the city or state; but during the~~

1 ~~tenure of holding office the city manager shall reside within the~~  
2 ~~city.~~ City managers or part-time city managers may appoint  
3 themselves, or the council or other authority may appoint or elect  
4 the city manager or part-time city manager, to other offices and  
5 positions in the city government, subject to regulations prescribed  
6 by ordinance; but the city manager or part-time city manager may not  
7 receive compensation for service in such other offices or positions.  
8 Neither the mayor nor any members of the city council may be  
9 appointed city manager or part-time city manager during the term for  
10 which they shall have been elected nor within two (2) years after  
11 they cease to hold such office.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
