6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; enacting
8 the Oklahoma Access to Health Care Act; directing
9 Oklahoma Health Care Authority to receive certain
10 funds for federal matching for specific purposes;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5501 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as
18 the "Oklahoma Access to Health Care Act".

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5502 of Title 63, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be responsible for
23 receiving an appropriate state share to be generated and matched by
24 the federal government for the purpose of addressing access to

1 health care services under existing state programs and providing
2 stability in provider reimbursement.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
