6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety;
8 prohibiting the Office of Chief Medical Examiner and
9 its employees from receiving certain compensation;
10 providing exception; providing for codification; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2210.2 of Title 63, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Neither the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner nor any
17 employee of the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner shall receive
18 compensation of any kind from any organ, eye or tissue recovery
19 organization except as otherwise provided by law.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
