5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Council on Law Enforcement
7 Education and Training; requiring execution of
8 certain agreement between the Council on Law
9 Enforcement Education and Training and peace officers
10 attending the basic law enforcement academy;
11 providing for civil action remedy upon violation of
12 contract; providing for attorney fees and costs;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.11 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Beginning November 1, 2009, any peace officer attending a
20 basic law enforcement academy conducted by the Council on Law
21 Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) shall execute an
22 agreement with CLEET whereby the peace officer promises to remain
23 within the law enforcement profession in the State of Oklahoma in a
24 position approved by rules and regulations of CLEET for four (4)
years following graduation from the basic law enforcement academy,

1 subject only to such disqualifications as established by CLEET and
2 included within the agreement between CLEET and the peace officer.

3 B. Violation of the provisions of this section or the terms of
4 any contract or agreement entered into pursuant to this section
5 shall give rise to a civil action which may be commenced by CLEET
6 for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma for restitution of any
7 and all sums paid by CLEET on behalf of the peace officer plus costs
8 and reasonable attorney fees.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
