9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to transportation; amending 69 O.S.  
11 2001, Section 1101, as amended by Section 1, Chapter  
12 264, O.S.L. 2007 (69 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1101),  
which relates to highway contracts; defining term;  
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1101, as  
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 2007 (69 O.S. Supp. 2008,  
18 Section 1101), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1101. A. All contracts for construction work upon the  
20 state highway system shall be let and awarded pursuant to the  
21 provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974. If the  
22 project advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Public  
23 Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is for the construction of more than  
24 eight (8) miles of road, and is not a surface treatment only

1 project, said advertisement shall provide for bids on sections of  
2 the road no longer than eight (8) miles, as well as bids on the  
3 project as a whole. If the project advertised pursuant to the  
4 provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is a  
5 surface treatment only project of more than twenty (20) miles of  
6 road, the advertisement shall provide for bids on sections of the  
7 road no longer than twenty (20) miles, as well as bids on the  
8 project as a whole. As used in this subsection, "surface treatment  
9 only" means those projects that address the surface of the road,  
10 highway, or bridge that do not add capacity or increase the  
11 structural integrity of the facility.

12 B. The Department may extend a contract no more than twenty-  
13 five percent (25%) of the length and extent of the original project.  
14 The price for the extension work shall not be greater than the  
15 contract unit basis.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
