9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Arts Council; making  
11 an appropriation; stating purpose; providing for the  
12 budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts;  
13 requiring certain performance measures for budget  
14 categories; providing for duties and compensation of  
15 employees; limiting the maximum salary of the Chief  
16 Administrative Officer; providing budgetary  
17 limitations; requiring budgeting of certain funds in  
18 certain years; requiring certain budget procedures;  
19 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing  
20 lapse dates; providing an effective date; and  
21 declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Arts  
24 Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
Oklahoma Arts Council by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Oklahoma Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following  
3 categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
13 upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council.  
14 The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed  
15 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Arts Council for the  
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
18 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as  
19 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
20 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

23 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be  
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).  
3 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
4 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds  
5 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall  
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June  
8 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay  
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after  
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
15 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been  
16 approved by the Office of State Finance.

17 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
