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8 AS INTRODUCED

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10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Board of Private
11 Vocational Schools; authorizing certain expenditures
12 for certain purposes; requiring certain funds be
13 budgeted in certain categories and amounts; requiring
14 performance measures for budget categories; providing
15 for duties and compensation of employees; limiting
the maximum salary of the Director; providing
budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting of certain
funds in certain years; requiring certain budgeting
procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;
providing lapse dates; providing an effective date;
and declaring an emergency.

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools is
20 hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30,
21 2010, from the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools
22 Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars
23 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
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1 imposed upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by
2 law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
4 Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools shall budget all funds
5 in the following categories and amounts:

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9 The Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by law shall
14 be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
15 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
16 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Board of
17 Private Vocational Schools, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
18 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
19 full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes:

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1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

20 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
