10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and
11 Mathematics; making an appropriation to the Board of
12 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and
13 Mathematics; stating purpose; requiring expenditure
14 of certain sum for certain purpose; requiring
15 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
16 requiring performance measures; providing for duties
17 and compensation of employees; limiting the maximum
18 salary of the Director; providing budgetary
19 limitations; making certain students eligible for
20 certain programs; requiring budgeting of certain
21 funds in certain years; providing lapse dates;
22 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting
23 certain budget procedures; providing an effective
24 date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any
monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of
the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum
of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Trustees
2 of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law.

3 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act,
4 the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended
5 for the purpose of developing and offering pilot outreach programs
6 in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404 of Title
7 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Board
9 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall
10 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

18 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance
19 measures for each budget category.

20 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be
23 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
24 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly

1 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma School of
2 Science and Mathematics for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
3 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
4 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
5 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
6 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes:

10 SECTION 5. Students who are enrolled in a consolidated school
11 district shall be eligible to apply to attend regional pilot
12 outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section
13 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes if all or part of the
14 consolidated school district is served by the technology center
15 school district.

16 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
8 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
9 approved by the Office of State Finance.

10 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

11 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
