8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Council on Judicial
11 Complaints; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; providing for duties and compensation of
14 employees; providing budgetary limitations; limiting
15 salary of the Director; providing lapse dates;
16 requiring and prohibiting certain budget practices;
17 providing an effective date; and declaring an
18 emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on
21 Judicial Complaints from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
22 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
23 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
24 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Council on Judicial Complaints shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law shall be set by the
10 Director of the Council on Judicial Complaints. The salary of the
11 Director of the Council on Judicial Complaints shall not exceed
12 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Council on Judicial
14 Complaints for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
15 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
16 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
17 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
18 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes:

23 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of State Finance.

17 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
